Joshua 6

Get to know me:

1. What is the greatest principle that you have learned in your life that you seek to pass along to others?

Into the Bible:

Read Joshua 6

1. How does this chapter illustrate the concept of obedience and trust in God, even when His commands might seem unusual or impractical?
2. How can we receive instructions and walking in obedience in our relationship with the Lord?
3. What can we learn from Rahab's situation? How did her actions of faith and loyalty impact her future?
4. What lesson can we learn from the act of sparing Rahab and her family, but destroying everything else?
5. Why was specific instructions given to avoid the things devoted to destruction? What implications does this have in our lives today?
6. Why do you think the text emphasizes the complete destruction of Jericho, including men, women, and animals?

7. When we consider our personal walks with the Lord, why is it important that we completely purge our sin and leave no room for sin to regrow in our hearts and lives? What does Ephesians 4:17-24 and Galatians 5:16-26 share with us in regards to this action?

8. How can the fate of Jericho reflect on the concept of divine justice and judgement?

9. How might devoting time, money, or resources be viewed as a form of giving back to the Lord or acknowledging His sovereignty in our lives?

10. How can we apply the principles of obedience as seen in this passage to the modern day situations where God's instructions might not align with our understanding or expectations?

11. How do you interpret the heavy curse Joshua places on the rebuilding of Jericho? What do you think this says about remembering and respecting God's judgement?

Application:

1. In what ways can you apply the three principles that Pastor Greg shared to your life this week?

 2. Overcoming adversity comes through faith in the Lord.
